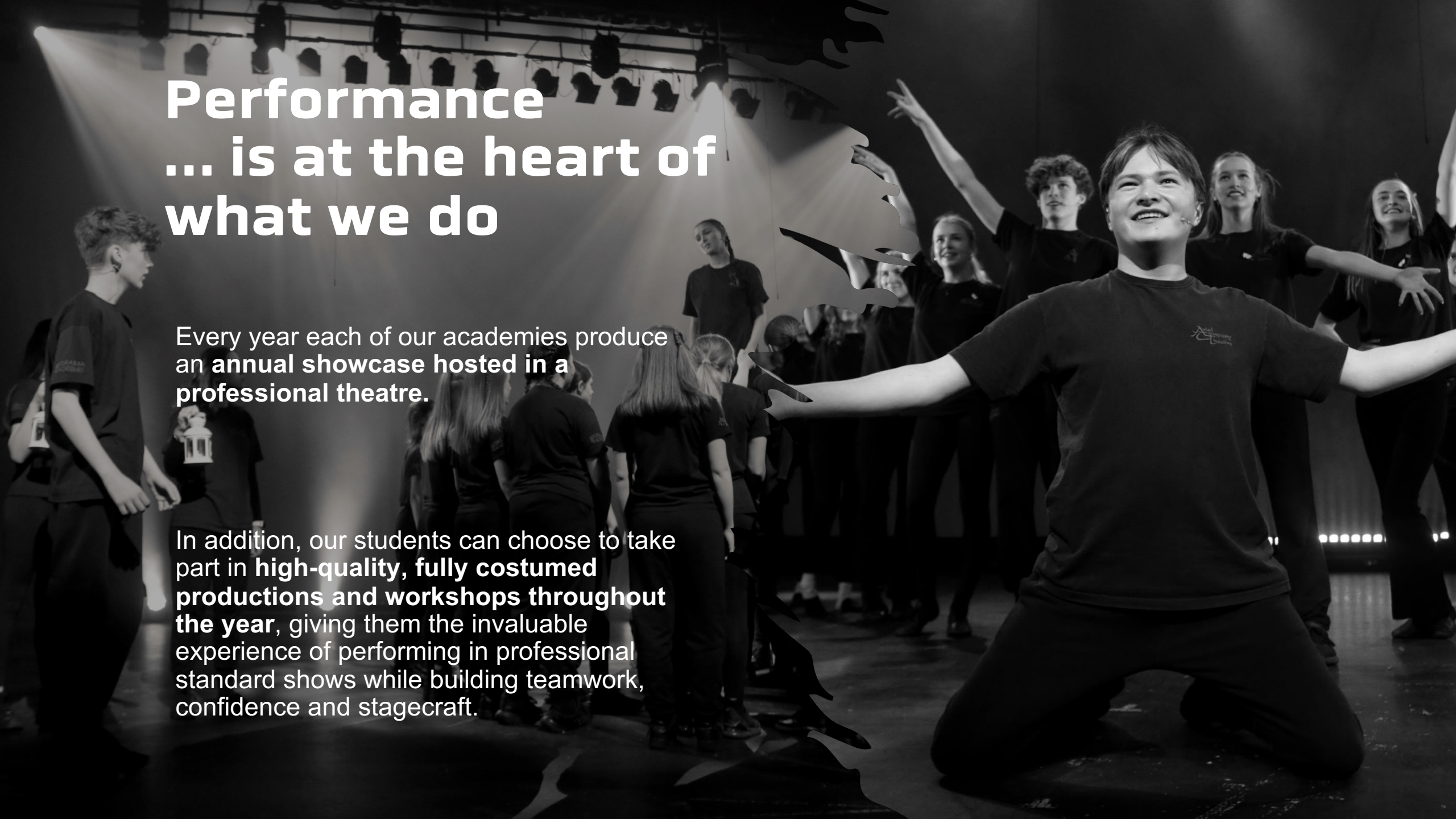
A very warm welcome to 'Ariel Drama Academies'

Students develop across all disciplines:

At Ariel, each academy is led by a dedicated Principal, supported by skilled Tutors, Support Tutors and a pastoral/administrative team. Many have worked at Ariel for years, bringing experience, creativity and passion for the arts. Together, they know the academy inside out and are committed to nurturing every student's unique talents.

Our curriculum is designed to provide a well-rounded performing arts education, ensuring Technical Skills

- ❖ Acting: voice projection, movement, characterisation, improvisation, creative writing, stagecraft, modern, contemporary and historic theatrical styles, contextual theatre.
- ❖ Singing: breath control, vocal range, diction, expression, tone, colour and intonation, with a focus on acting through song.
- ❖ Dance: rhythm, coordination, flexibility, posture and musicality across a variety of dance styles.
- ❖ A combination of acting, singing and dance not only equips students with core theatrical skills but also develops life skills such as teamwork, resilience and creativity. These disciplines bring mental and emotional benefits, building confidence, communication and self-expression, while giving every student a real sense of pride in their achievements.

- ❖ Bringing together singing, acting and dance to create versatile and confident performers who understand how to combine these disciplines into one dynamic art form.

Themed Projects

- ❖ Carefully devised projects that complement each other, encouraging creativity, collaboration and ensemble skills, while allowing students to take ownership of their work.

- ❖ Preparation for Ariel's annual showcase performed in a professional theatre. This is a highlight of the year, giving every student the chance to experience performing on a large stage in front of an audience.

WHAT ARE YOU DOING NOW?

I'VE STARTED REHEARSALS FOR THE UK TOUR OF *SUNNY AFTERNOON* (OCT 2025–MAY 2026), UNDERSTUDYING THE THREE FEMALE ROLES.

DID ARIEL INFLUENCE YOUR CAREER GOALS?

YES—ARIEL WAS THE KEY REASON I PURSUED MUSICAL THEATRE. IT COMPLEMENTED MY DANCE TRAINING AND GAVE ME THE TOOLS TO SUCCEED AT DRAMA SCHOOL. MOST IMPORTANTLY, THE TUTORS TAUGHT ME TO BELIEVE IN MYSELF, SHAPING THE PERFORMER I AM TODAY.

WHAT ARE YOU DOING NOW?

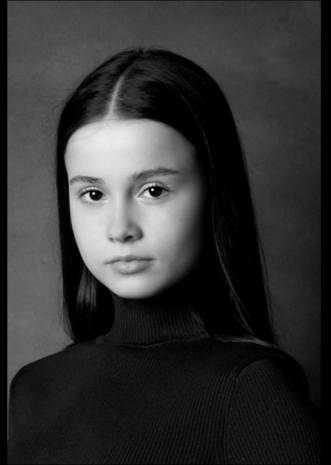

WHEN DID YOU JOIN ARIEL?

I JOINED IN FEBRUARY 2015 WHEN I HAD JUST TURNED 4 – SO I’VE NOW BEEN PART OF ARIEL FOR 10 YEARS!

HOW DO YOU FEEL IT HAS BENEFITED YOU?

I’VE LEARNED SO MANY THEATRICAL SKILLS AND DISCOVERED A REAL PASSION FOR PERFORMANCE. MORE THAN THAT, I’VE GROWN IN CONFIDENCE, DEVELOPED LEADERSHIP SKILLS, AND MADE SOME OF MY BEST FRIENDS. I LOOK FORWARD TO EVERY WEEKEND AND THE EXTRA OPPORTUNITIES LIKE SHOWCASES, WORKSHOPS, AND SHOWS. SUPPORTING THE YOUNGER HAMLETS CLASS (WHERE I STARTED) AND THE OTHELLOS GROUP HAS TAUGHT ME HOW TO HELP CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS, WHICH HAS BEEN SO REWARDING. I’VE ALSO TAKEN THREE LAMDA EXAMS WITH 1:1 TRAINING, WHICH NOT ONLY IMPROVED MY ACTING BUT TAUGHT ME HOW TO MANAGE PRESSURE AND AUDITIONS.

HOW HAS BEING PART OF ARIEL HELPED YOU FEEL INCLUDED AND SUPPORTED, AND WHAT MAKES THIS DIFFERENT FROM OTHER PLACES YOU’VE EXPERIENCED? WHAT ARE YOU DOING NOW?

AS SOMEONE WITH COMPLEX MEDICAL NEEDS, ARIEL HAS GIVEN ME A PLACE WHERE THERE ARE NO BARRIERS—I’M ACCEPTED AND TREATED EQUALLY. OTHER PLACES SOMETIMES WORRY ABOUT MY NEEDS, BUT AT ARIEL I’M SIMPLY ME, CARED FOR AND RESPECTED. RECENTLY I PERFORMED IN CHARLIE AND THE CHOCOLATE FACTORY AT THE THEATRE ROYAL (INCLUDING DANCING BALLET IN THE WORLD’S BIGGEST SQUIRREL COSTUME AND PLAYING OOMPA LOOMPAS IN COUNTLESS WIGS!). I ALSO PERFORMED IN OLIVER! AT THE SAME VENUE, AND I’M NOW REHEARSING FOR ARIEL’S BUGSY MALONE AT THE NEW BURY THEATRE, WHERE I’M DANCE CAPTAIN, FEATURE DANCER, AND PLAYING TILLY.

IN WHAT WAYS DOES ARIEL’S COMMUNITY MAKE YOU FEEL WELCOMED AND VALUED?

TUTORS ALWAYS LISTEN TO OUR IDEAS AND GIVE RECOGNITION FOR OUR CONTRIBUTIONS. LAST TERM, I WAS PROUD TO BE ASKED TO CHOREOGRAPH A TEMPESTS SINGING PIECE—IT MADE ME FEEL VERY VALUED.
